Dear Mr. President,

As we have informed you a few days ago, the delegation of Israel has to leave the GC at the end of Thursday's discussions due to the beginning of "Rosh Hashanah", the Jewish New Year.

We have made a great effort with the help of many distinguished Member States to reach an agreement that will ensure that no-action is taken on Agenda Item no. 21. However, it was not possible to reach the same agreement as last year's and further suggestions we made were turned down.

The Israeli Ambassador to the IAEA has been instructed that if a resolution under item no. 21 will be brought to a vote, Israel will not be able to support the resolutions under Agenda items no.20. I would like to stress that this is a lamentable and unfortunate outcome that will certainly have a bearing on our considerations in the future.

We would be grateful if you could circulate this letter to all member states.
