


## Outcome & Follow-up of the Review / I.R. IRAN

- The efficiency of the UPR will depend on concrete outcome and follow-up. The Human Rights Council will make recommendations on each country reviewed through a final statement, resolution or report for each country.
- Outcome of the UPR should have the same format for all reviewed states. The outcome could also reflect the areas of agreement for capacity building and technical assistance <sup>to</sup> implement the recommendations <sup>through</sup> ~~equal~~ voluntary measures.
- A task force which comprised of the HRC members should be appointed for each and every country. Members of task force should be elected based on equitable geographical distribution (3 countries from each region).
- The outcome text should include recommendations on the type of action to be undertaken, a follow-up procedure taking into account the respective national specificities and both set of the rights.
- Space for genuine interactive dialogue with the States concerned at the final stage of the process is needed.
- Follow-up mechanisms for implementation of recommendations made by the Council is a required part of the process.
- We ~~strongly~~ support proposal of Brazil on preparing a 'global report'.

Views, and responses of the Country under review should be reflected in the Final outcome of the review.
