PP1 Guided by the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations,

PP2 Recalling all of its relevant resolutions on the situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question,

PP3 Reiterating its demand that all parties comply with their obligations under international law, including international humanitarian law and international human rights law,

PP4 Expressing deep concern about the catastrophic humanitarian situation in the Gaza Strip,

OP1 *Demands* an immediate humanitarian ceasefire for the month of Ramadan respected by all parties leading to a permanent sustainable ceasefire,

OP2 *Demands* the immediate and unconditional release of all hostages, as well as ensuring humanitarian access to address their medical and other humanitarian needs, and further demands that the parties comply with their obligations under international law in relation to all persons they detain,

OP3 Emphasizes the urgent need to expand the flow of humanitarian assistance to and reinforce the protection of civilians in the entire Gaza Strip and reiterates its demand for the lifting of all barriers to the provision of humanitarian assistance at scale, in line with international humanitarian law as well as resolutions 2712 (2023) and 2720 (2023),

OP4 Decides to remain actively seized of the matter.
