- -Revising the budgetary needs of the organisms in charge of the promotion of Human Rights.
- -Struggling against racism and all forms of discrimination and religious intolerance, based on a constructive dialogue among States.
- -Working on the approval of relevant Human Rights instruments, including the United Nations Declarations on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples; the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance and the Additional Protocol of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights.
